Know India Programme (KIP) is an important initiative of Government of India to engage the diaspora youth and connect them to India.

## KIP is a 21-day orientation programme organized by the Ministry of External Affairs for diaspora youth between age 18-30 with an aim to acquaint them with the transformational change taking place in India.

The Ministry extends complete hospitality to the selected participants during their stay in India, and bears 90% of the cost of international fare. The remaining 10% is borne by the selected candidate. The program is open to Indian origin youths (excluding the one holding Indian passports).

The Ministry has so far successfully organized 65 KIPs since 2003 in partnership with different states. The Ministry has now announced the dates for the 66<sup>th</sup> and 67<sup>th</sup> KIP and the registration is open for Indian Origin Youths. The details are as below:
